For statements marked (rev) below, the participant's responses should be reverse scored, so  $1 \Rightarrow 7$ ,  $2 \Rightarrow 6$ ,  $3 \Rightarrow 5$ ,  $4 = 4$ ,  $5 \Rightarrow 3$ ,  $6 \Rightarrow 2$ ,  $7 \Rightarrow 1$ . Then total each section for their score in each of the sub-domains. Finally, total each of the of the sub-domains to calculate the participant's overall intellectual humility (IH) score.
